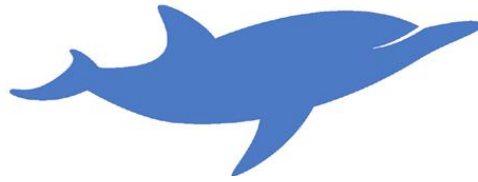

OCEAN COLLEGE INTERNSHIP

DM Program Structure

Prerequisites –

- Minimum 18 years old**
- Minimum 20 logged dives**
- PADI Rescue Diver**
- CPR/1st Aid certification (within 2 years)**
- Current medical stating fitness to dive (within 1 year)**
- DAN professional insurance**

DM course will start within first two days of arriving in resort after welcome, induction and settling in period.

DM course will run for 4 weeks under the direct guidance of an Ocean College senior instructor and will follow all PADI standards and procedures. All candidates will also assist with daily boat guiding, again under direct supervision, to learn daily boat procedures, dive sites and differing environmental conditions, briefings, safety procedures, administration and logistics.

DM will also assist with a range of PADI courses including DSD, Scuba Reviews, Scuba Diver and Open Water Diver and continuing education courses.

There will be plenty of time for any remedial training and to study for the theory exam.

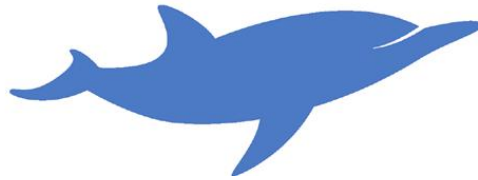
Daily Boat Diving

All successful candidates completing their DM will then assist on Ocean College boats and courses to put into practice what you have learnt during the DM course. There is no better way to improve one's skills and knowledge than to actually assist with guiding and courses (again under direct supervision).

TDI Basic & Advanced Nitrox and Deco Procedures

Living in Sharm

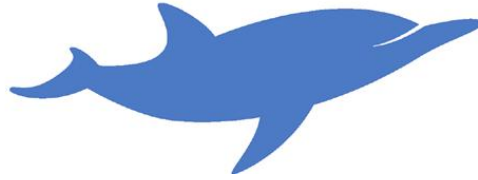
